**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Public Law 27-31, on January 15, 2004, Judicial Council appointed Perry C. Taitano to be the Administrator of the Courts in Judicial Council Resolution JC04-002;


**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. JC04-002 incorporated by reference Mr. Taitano's Contract for Employment for a Specific Project;

**WHEREAS**, the Contract states that Mr. Taitano "shall have all authority previously assigned to the Administrators of the Superior and Supreme Courts;"

**WHEREAS**, it was and is the intent of the Judicial Council that such authority include all the responsibilities of the former Administrators, including the execution of contracts and personnel actions and other such documents affecting the operation of the Judiciary.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Judicial Council hereby authorizes Mr. Taitano to be the authorized signatory on all documents affecting the administration of the Judicial Branch including both the Supreme and Superior Courts.


